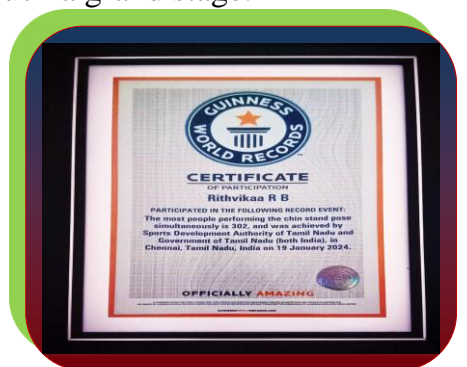
INTERNATIONAL TIGER DAY

NUMBERS PAINTING

Our PRE-KG kids enjoyed the activity by painting the numbers. Through this activity, they were able to identify and recognize the numbers and understand the set of objects in counting .It helped the kids to improve their mental skills and critical-thinking.



HAND GLOVE PUPPET ACTIVITY

Through this activity kids of LKG learnt how to make Hand Glove Puppet using gloves, goggle eyes and pompom balls. It helped the kids to develop social and emotional skills, hand - eye coordination, fine motor skills, speech and language development.



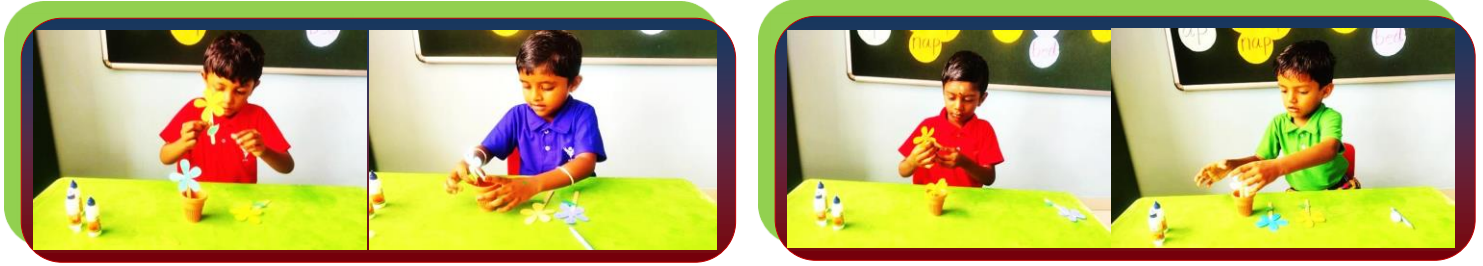
HUMAN BODY MODEL

The human body is made up of many small structures like cells, tissues, organs and systems that work together to perform the necessary functions for sustaining life. Our LKG kids made a human body model using ice - cream sticks and color paper. It helped the kids to know about the function of body parts.



RHYMING WORDS

Rhyming words are two or three words that have the same ending sound. Our little charms of UKG explored the rhyming words using magical letters in a creative flower pot. Through this activity our UKG kids learnt to repeat sounds and patterns, to read and form words. It helped the kids to enhance their phonemic awareness, reading, vocabulary and speaking skills.



FRAMING SENTENCES

Framing sentence mean a proper way of arranging a sentence that it would give a right meaning. Our UKG kids took part in an activity where they framed sentences about their favorite activities. It helped the kids to improve their language skills and boost their vocabulary. Overall, it was an engaging way to develop both linguistic abilities and self-expression.



ALPHABET ACTIVITY

Learning alphabet is the foundation of our spoken language, gives us the advantage of knowing how letters and words are pronounced. Our little champs of UKG participated in spoon activity where they used spoons to create images representing the first letter of their names. Through this activity our children were able to reinforce their knowledge of the alphabet, identify and recall the letters.



PROCESS OF GROWING CROPS

Growing crops is essential agricultural practice that involves several stages from preparation to harvest. To understand each step in achieving healthy and productive crops, our students of GRADE 5 did a project model on agricultural practices. These models provide a comprehensive overview for students to understand the stages involved in growing crops.



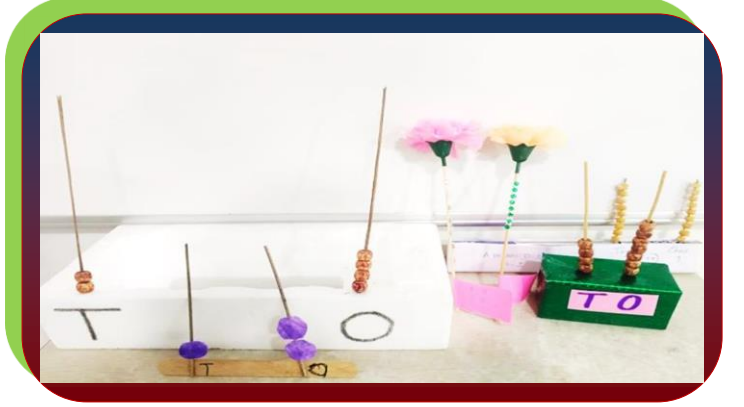
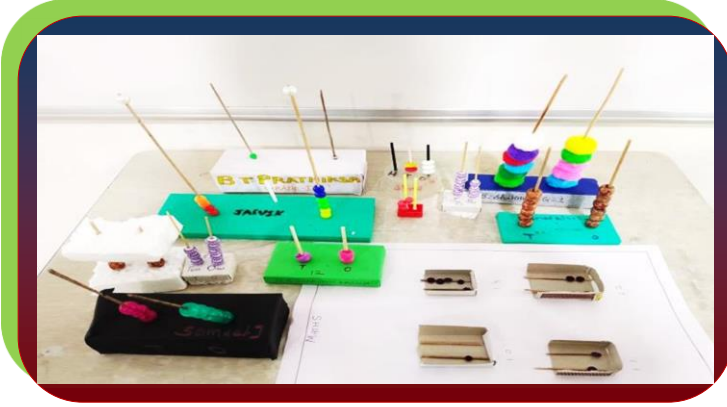
வாசித்துப்பழகுதல்

Through this activity our children learnt the basics of counting 2 - digit numbers, place value, addition and subtraction. It also helps the children to improve their logical thinking and problem solving capacity.



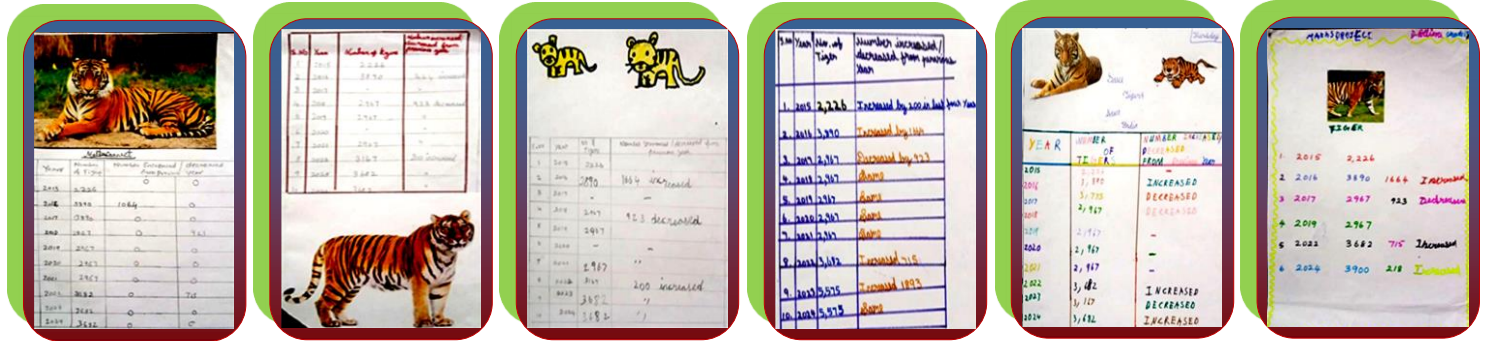
LEAF IMPRESSION

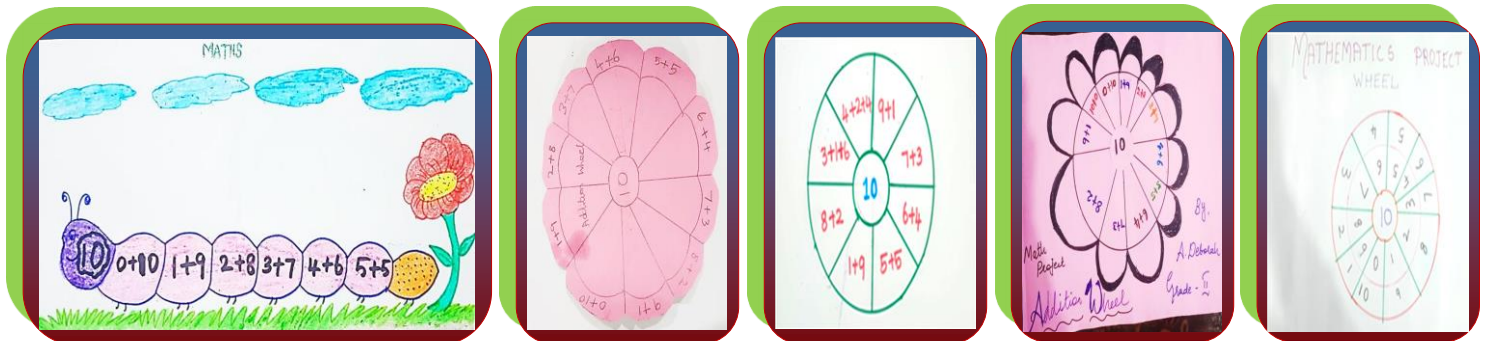
MATHS CONNECT

Forests are home to a large number of animals. But human activities in forests are a threat to animal population in the wild. The tiger is now an endangered animal. Our GRADE 4 students did a research to find out how many tigers have decreased or increased from 2015 to 2024 using mathematical process like subtraction or addition operations.



ADDITION WHEEL ACTIVITY

Every student begins their math journey by learning to add simple numbers. Addition is a basic arithmetic operation. Our GRADE 2 children made Addition Wheels to improve the automaticity needed when it comes to the basic facts of addition. Through this activity our children also develop crucial mathematical skills such as number sense, counting, and mental math.



PAPER MACHE MODEL OF EARTH

Paper Mache model helps children to experiment and express themselves artistically. It helps to develop imagination by bringing the real image to focus. This project of making "Earth" out of paper mache, is done by our GRADE 3 artists. It improves cognitive development by observing on how to paste the color papers in the position of continents and oceans. This gives them an idea of how oceans and continents are placed on Earth's surface.



SPEAKING ACTIVITY USING REQUEST WORDS

Communication is a must to convey our thoughts to others. Though we are clear in our thoughts the words we use also must be correct to convey our message to others in a right way. As a startup for this students of GRADE 3 were engaged in speaking activity using request words like “Can I”, “Could I”, “May I”, “Please” in different situations. Children too actively participated in the activity and learnt the usage of words in a correct manner.



EXPLORATION OF INDIAN CULTURE THROUGH FOOD

As a part of learning about Culture and Heritage of India, our GRADE 4 children learnt about various cultural aspects like dress, food, handicrafts, languages, architecture etc. To make learning more interesting, they explored different food items that were the special dish of various states. This activity helped them to range over various foods that depicted the culture and lifestyle of people in each state.



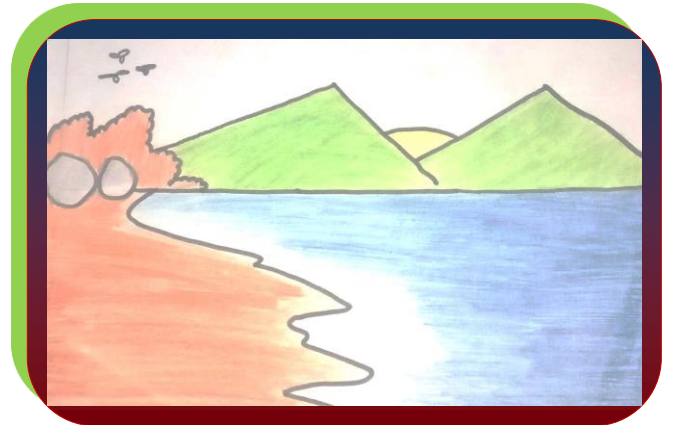

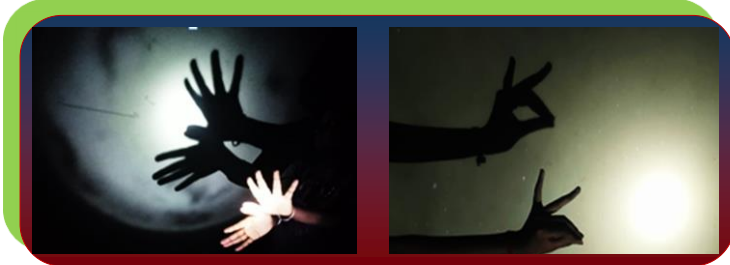
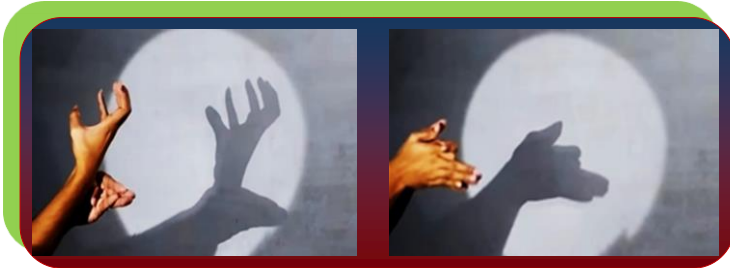
SEED DISPERSAL MECHANISM

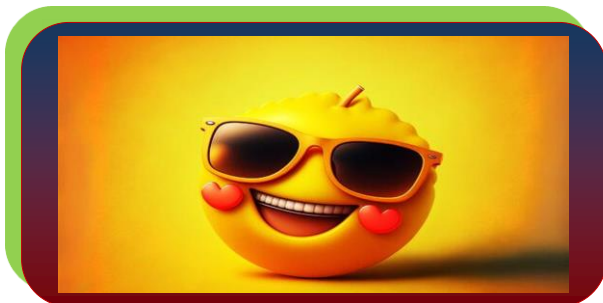
“THREE QUESTIONS”
