KIDDO FEST – 2024 (LEVEL – I)

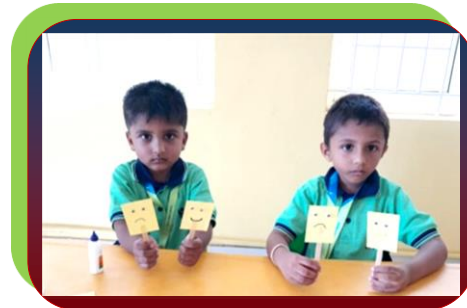

ACTIVITIES

PLACARDS ACTIVITY

An emotion is a feeling such as happiness, love, fear, anger which can be caused by the situation of the people. Our PRE-KG kids made an emotion placards using color paper and ice-cream sticks. Through this activity, kids learnt to identify the different emotions and helped them to build good relationship.



PUZZLE ACTIVITY

A chess board puzzle can refer to a variety of puzzles that use chess pieces and a chess board. Our PRE-KG kids solved a chess puzzle using chess board pieces. Through this activity, kids learnt to improve tactical skills, critical thinking abilities and problem solving capabilities.



GEOBOARD ACTIVITY

It helped the kids to explore the properties of shapes, fine motor skills, eye hand coordination, memory, focus, etc.,

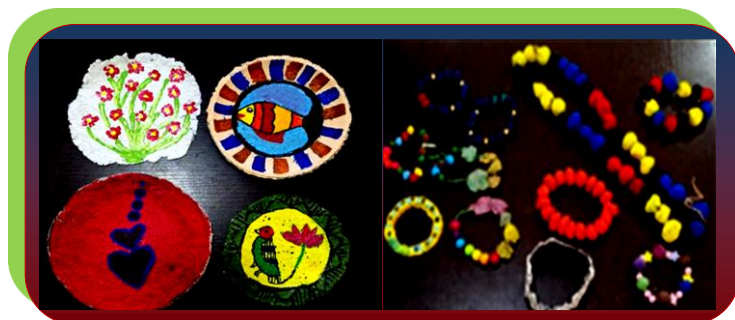


CLOWN ACTIVITY

Our UKG kids made a clown model using thermocol, ribbon, pom-pom and color paper. This activity improves hand eye coordination, thinking and creative skills.

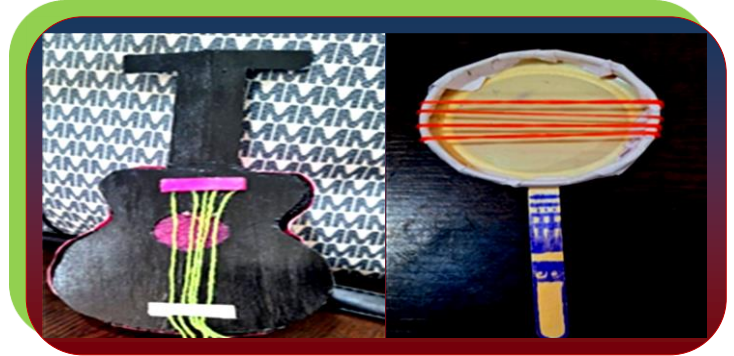
PAPER MACHE ACTIVITY

FIRELESS COOKING

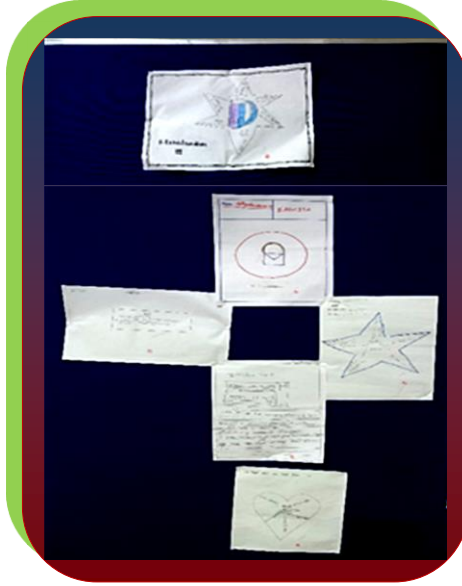

WRITING ACTIVITY

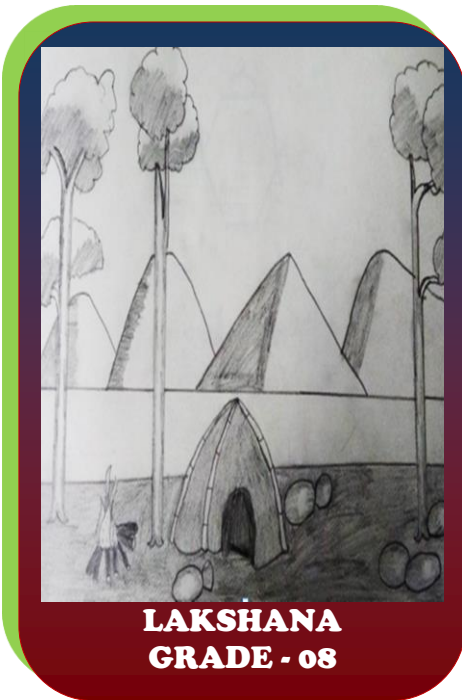
