ACTIVITIES

ELEPHANT MODEL ACTIVITY

Our PRE-KG kids made an elephant face using colour paper, foam and circle cutout of cardboard. Through this activity kids learnt to identify animal and structure of an animal. It helped the kids to develop fine motor skills, environmental awareness, patience and persistence.









SPONGE IMPRINT ACTIVITY

Sponge painting is a coating application technique that gives an interesting texture and appearance to a surface. Our PRE-KG kids did sponge imprints on tortoise image using paint and sponge. Through this activity kids learnt about different animals and amphibians etc. It helped the kids to develop hand-eye coordination, sensory exploration, fine motor skills and environmental awareness.





FENCE MAKING ACTIVITY

Fence making refers to the process of designing, building and installing fences, which are structures used to enclose, divide, or protect areas. Our LKG kids made a fence for a model grass land by using ice-cream sticks, grass mat, white cardboard, animals and string sticks. Through this activity kids learnt to identify animals, explore texture, enhance sensory, fine motor and social skills.







DOG MODEL ACTIVITY

Our LKG kids made a Dog model using tissue roll, white paper, googly eyes, petals and circle cutouts. Through this activity LKG kids learnt to enhance their creativity and imagination.











DRAWING ACTIVITY

Our UKG students explored their creativity through a farm animal drawing activity. This engaging exercise enhanced their fine motor skills and introduced them to diverse farm animals. Vibrant artwork showcased their imagination and learning.



HEN MODEL ACTIVITY

Our UKG students creatively explored "Hen Activity" using gloves, feathers and colorful papers. This innovative activity refined fine motor skills and fostered imagination. Artistic expression flourished in every colorful design.










"DREAM BIG: EMPOWERING THE KIDS TO CREATE THEIR FEATURE"




ART OF CARVING
