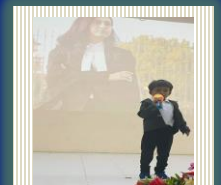
Our school provided a traditional meal known as Sadhya to all our staff members as a part of Onam celebration

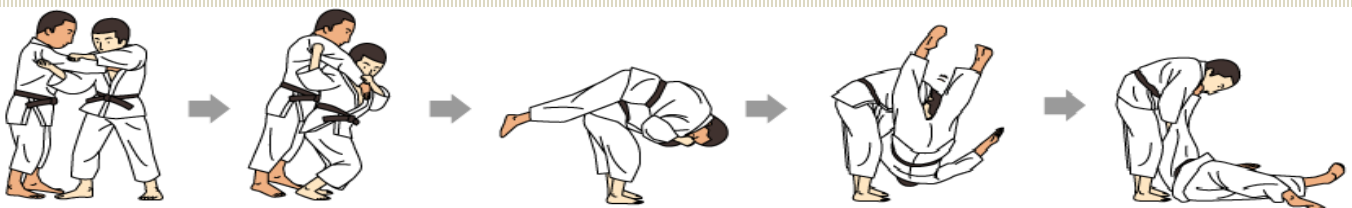

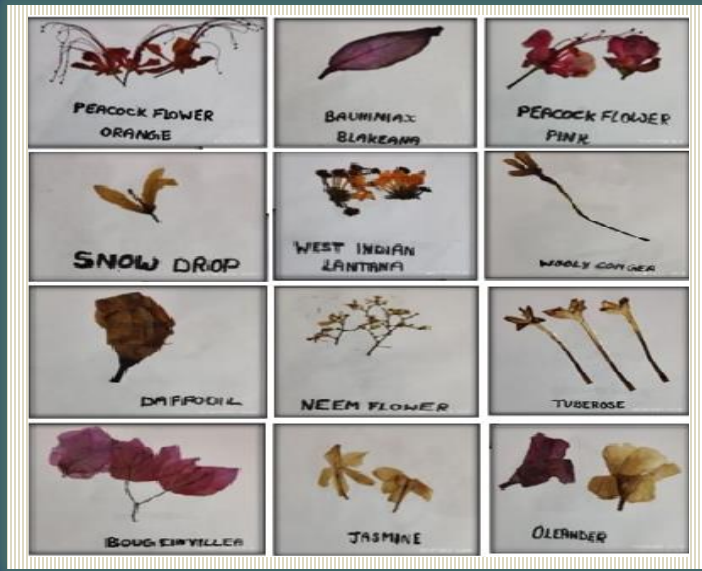
FLOWER ALBUM

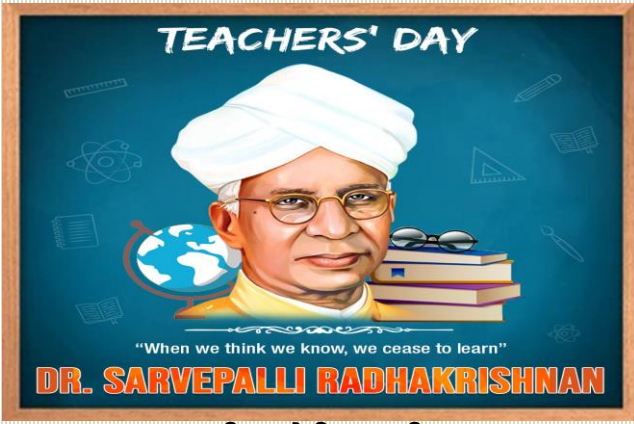

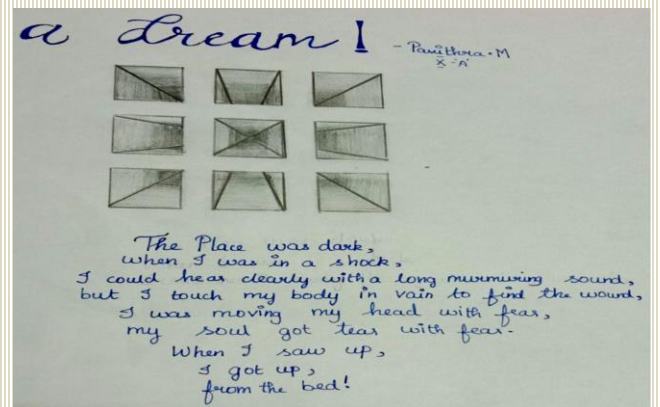

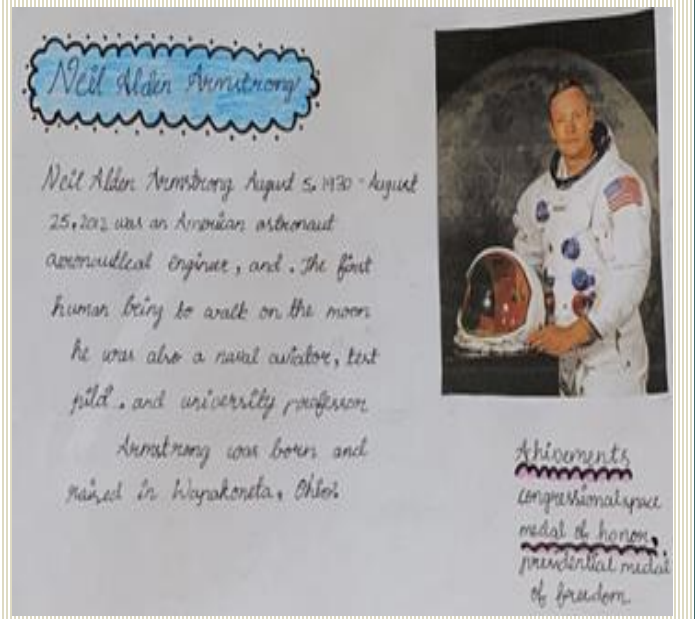

Arts and Crafts is an integral tool in child development as it fuels their curiosity, creativity and provides them with an outlet to observe, express, explore, excel through creating things. In addition, the freedom of creating and experimenting with this practice provides them not only helps them with skills such as motor, language, problem-solving but helps them to deal with various stressors while simultaneously discovering and familiarizing themselves, others, and the environment around them.

The importance of Art and crafts spreads to academic excellence as well. Despite the common misconception, Arts and Crafts actually help children with their concentration, thinking skills, visual learning, and more, which has proven to increase IQ levels. In addition, arts and crafts are a great assistive tool that helps with sensory learning, especially for children with ADHD (Neurodevelopment disorder of childhood), dyslexia, or similar conditions.

POPSICLE STICK CRAFTS











Meanwhile, cognitive skills slowly develop every time they create something new out of popsicle sticks. During this process, children will stumble upon challenges that will test their decision-making skills and will compel them to become innovative.
