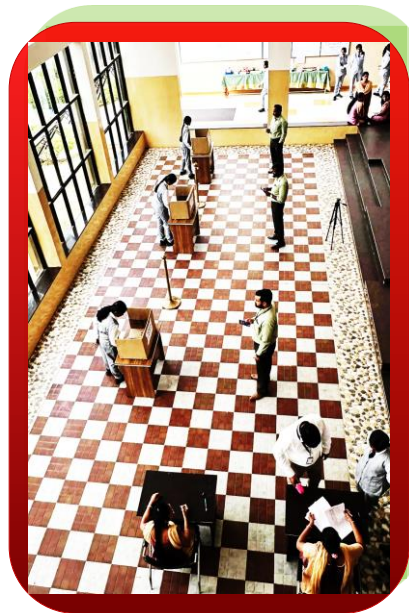
BACK TO SCHOOL

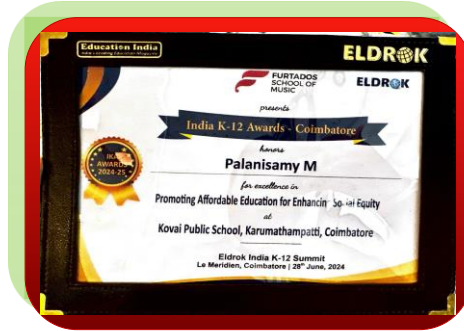

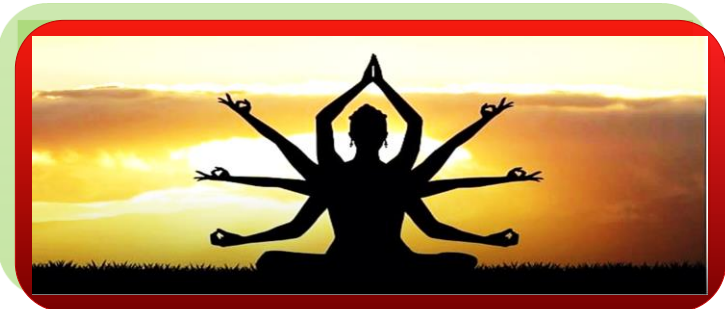
ELDROK, INDIA K-12 AWARDS (IKS-2024)

ACTIVITIES

PAPER FOLDING

Paper folding is an age-old technique used to teach children the art of folding paper to create unique shapes. Paper folding is often referred to as “Origami”. Origami is used for all paper folding practices.

Our PRE-KG kids learnt to fold the paper in different shapes, size and sculpting technique. It helped the kids to develop their fine motor skill, eye-hand coordination, creativity, multisensory organs and mental ability.



PAPER CRUMBLING

Crumbling activity is a great hand strength activity, the kids were provided with pre-cut rectangular paper. In crumbling activity kids squeeze, crumble and crush the paper to make small paper ball. Through this activity kids of PRE-KG learnt to crumble the paper into small balls which helps them to develop their finger grip, fine motor skill, hand eye coordination muscle strength and refined movements.



WIND CHIME ACTIVITIES ON EMOTIONS

Emotions are reactions that human beings experience in response to events or situations. Emotions have a strong influence in our daily lives. We make decisions based on our emotions. Our LKG kids made a wind chime using the emotion cards. Through this activity, our kids learnt about various emotions like happy, sad, cry, surprise, fear etc. It helped the kids to develop their self –awareness, empathy, motivation, kindness and social awareness.



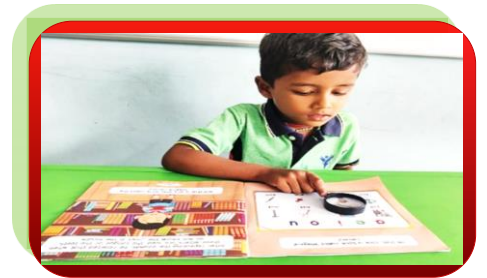
PALM PRINT ACTIVITY

Palm print is an excellent sensory-based activity that can benefit individuals of all early ages. Our little dots of LKG splattered their palms with different colors and put a print on a paper. It helped in developing fine motor skills, eye-hand coordination, and creativity. Children got a chance to feel and play with the colors.



MAGICAL LETTERS

Vowels are important as they form the basis for many of the words in English language. This is because vowels are necessary for creating syllables and therefore being able to articulate different sounds and words. Our little champs of UKG were engaged in magical letters activity with the help of magnifying glass. It helped the kids to improve hand-eye coordination, enhance reading skills, and strengthen language skills.



FAMILY TREE (SCIENCE ACTIVITY)

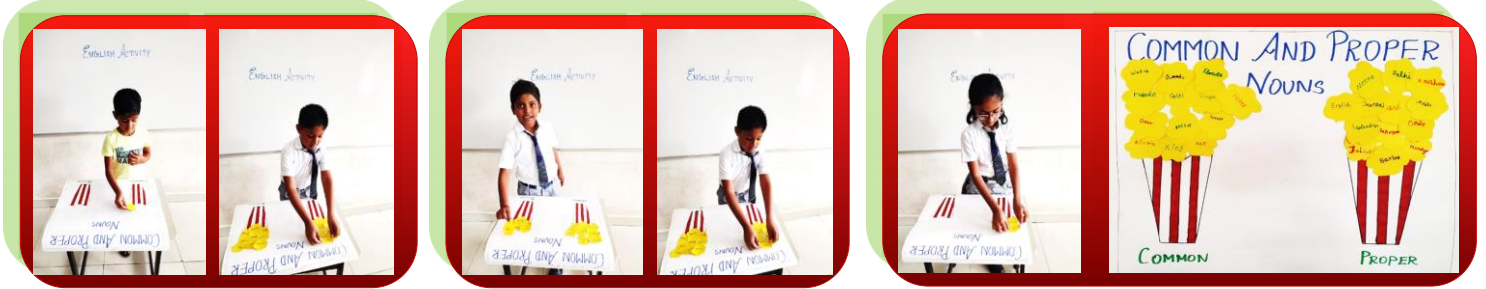

SORTING COMMON AND PROPER NOUNS

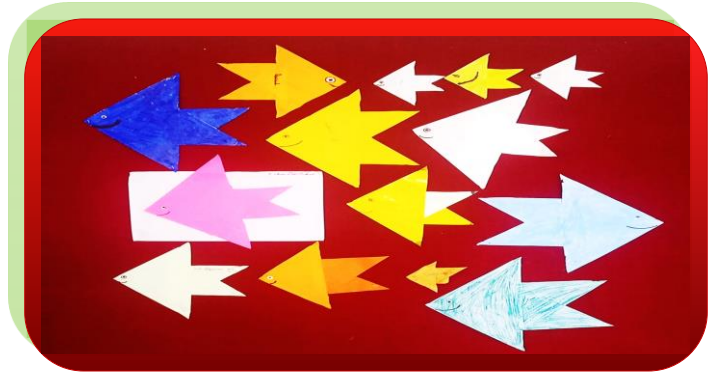

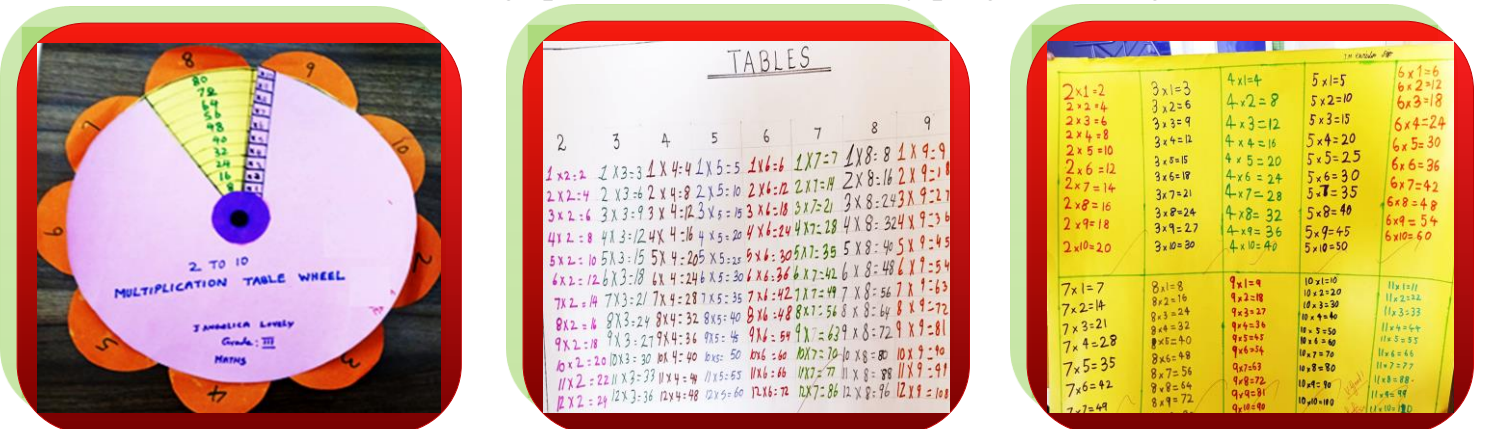

Multiplication is the main tool for many forms of maths such as algebra, calculus, equations and more.

Our grade 3 students prepared multiplication charts in a colourful manner to familiarize themselves and feel confident with the teachings presented to them as they progress through education.

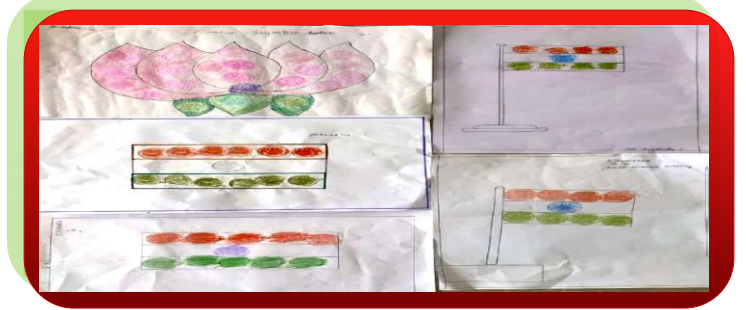

NATIONAL SYMBOLS

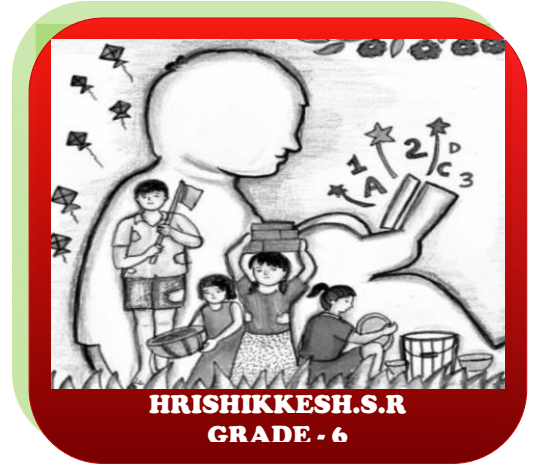

मात्रा गतिविधि



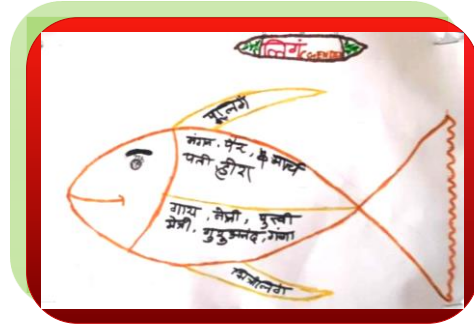
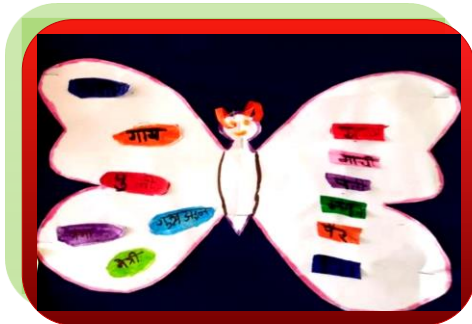

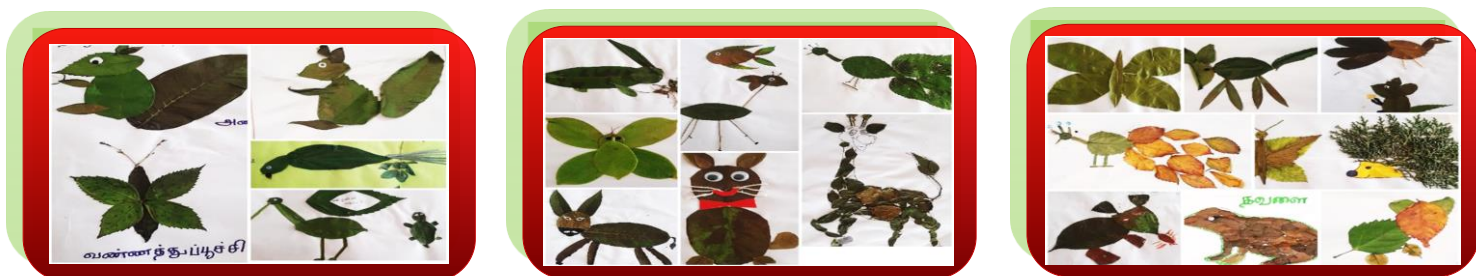
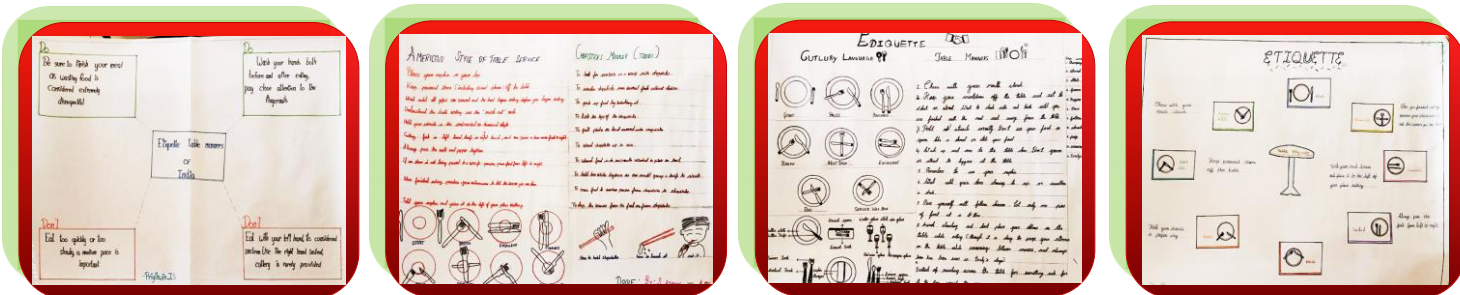


TABLE ETIQUETTE

At this point of time it's important for us to know the importance of formal dining etiquette. Our students from grade 7 did a chart presentation on dining etiquette. It showed that they are respectful, professional, and have good manners. This can help them build stronger relationships and increase their chances of success in business.



INDICATORS IN OUR DAY-TO-DAY LIFE

We would have heard that people sent secret messages in confidential matters in olden days. They have used some invisible ink which can be read only using certain methodologies. We can also create such kind of technologies using some simple things which is available in our home. One such activity is writing the messages in soap solution which remains invisible. Later on, when some turmeric solution is applied, the message can be read as it becomes visible and can be read.

Chemistry that works behind this; Indicators are substances used to identify acids and bases. Our grade 7 student's applied the turmeric solution on a paper in which they have already written a message with soap solution. Once the turmeric solution was applied, the message written in the paper appeared in red color. Through this activity, children learnt that soap is a base and turmeric can be used to identify the bases.
