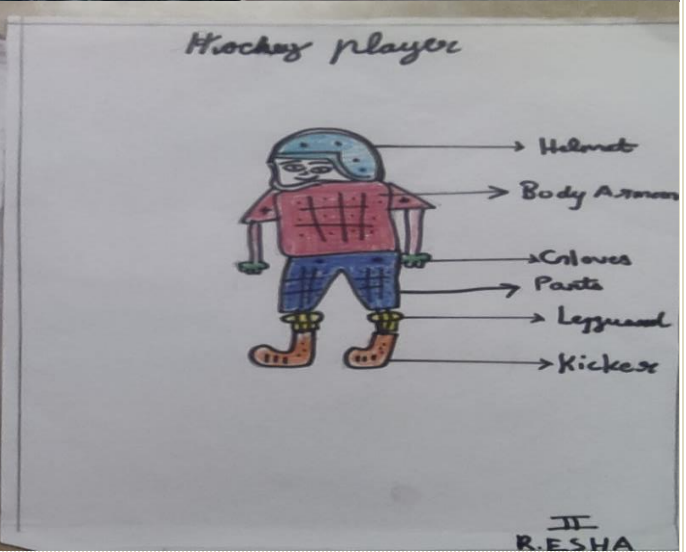
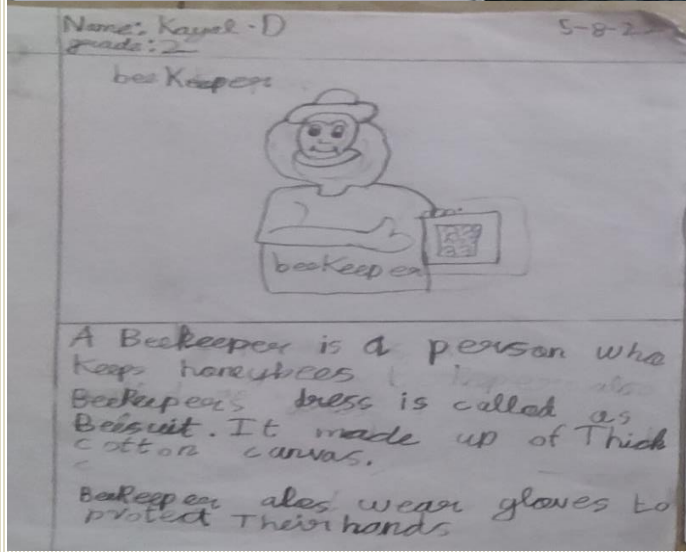
### गणेश चतुर्थी

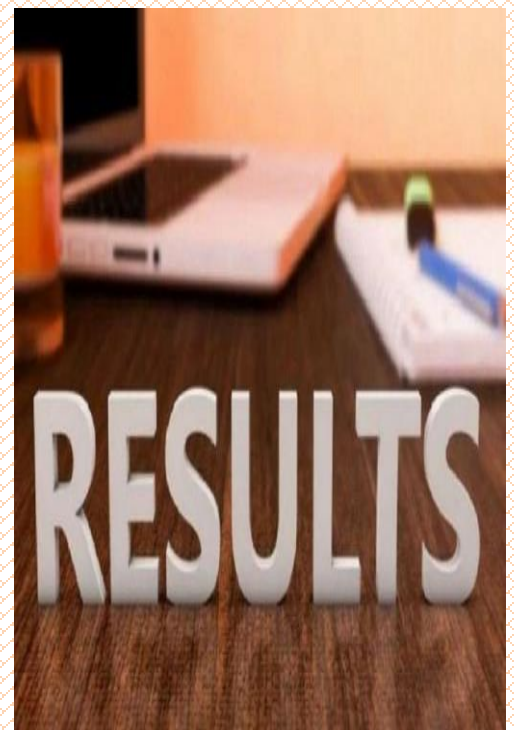
## BOARD RESULT

Louis Braille (4 January, 1809-6 January 1852) was a French educator. He invented a reading and writing system for people who cannot see. We still use his system to this day, and is known everywhere as Braille. Grade – 6 Students.

Louis Braille was a French educator and inventor of a reading and writing system for people who are visually impaired. He was born on January 4, 1809, Coupvray, France. He is known for Braille. By 1824, at just 15 years, Louis had found a way to use a six-dot cell in an area no larger than a fingertip.

Braille

Braille is a tactile code enabling blind and visually impaired people to read and write by touch, with various combinations of raised dots representing the alphabet, words, punctuation, and numbers. Braille is difficult to learn. On average it takes about 4 months to learn the uncontracted version, and upto 2 years for contracted.

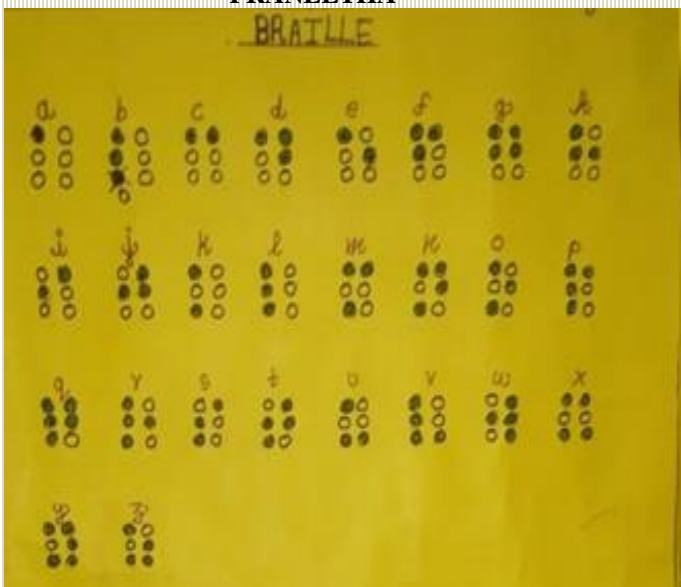

**Louis Braille :-**  
 Louis Braille was born on 4<sup>th</sup> January 1809, and died on 6<sup>th</sup> January, 1852.  
 He was a french educator and he invented the reading, writing system for blind people.  
 Braille was blinded at the age of three in one eye as a result it spreads and affects the other eye so he is completely blind.  
 Braille received a scholarship to France's Royal Institute for blind people.  
 In adulthood, Louis Braille served as professor at the Institute.  
 He was 43 years old when he died.

ABOUT LOUIS BRATILE

Louis Braille was a French educator born on 4<sup>th</sup> January 1809 and brought up in a small town Coupvray in France, about thirty miles east of Paris. He was along with his three elder siblings who lived with their parents in a small house near the countryside. Braille was blinded at the age of three in one eye as a result of an accident with a candle that fell on his father's hearth making shop. Consequently an infection set in and spread to both eyes, resulting in total blindness. At the time there were not many resources in place for the blind, but nevertheless, he enrolled in the education and received a scholarship to France's Royal Institute for blind people. His blindness led him to develop a system that allowed blind people to read and write quickly and efficiently. The system is called Braille. Inspired by the system invented by Charles Barbier, Braille developed a new method that was more compact and had eight to 25 ways of using, including music. He presented his work to the Paris for the first time in 1826. In adulthood, Louis Braille became as a professor at the Institute and had an operation in a Parisian, but he largely spent the remainder of his life writing and teaching his system. It was named for him shortly after many years after his death, but probably has recognized Braille as a revolutionary method, and it has been adapted for use in language workbooks.

## FIRE FLIES

### HOW AND WHY DO FIREFLIES GLOW?

Fireflies glow because of the reason of chemical reaction called bioluminescence naturally taking place. Not only fireflies, but aquatic animals, bacteria's and some more organisms too produce light. Scientists have discovered about 70 species of fungi which have the ability to produce light.

### How does this happen on fireflies?

Fireflies contain Calcium, Adenosine triphosphate and luciferin in its body. These three substances get reacted with oxygen and produce an enzyme called luciferase on the firefly. With the help of this enzyme, they produce light on their own. Bioluminescence is a "cold light". It doesn't produce any heat, like the light from a bulb

### Why do fireflies produce light?

Male fireflies produce light to attract female fireflies and to confuse its predators and protect themselves from danger.
